

Boosting Digital Skills and Competencies in Forest Education

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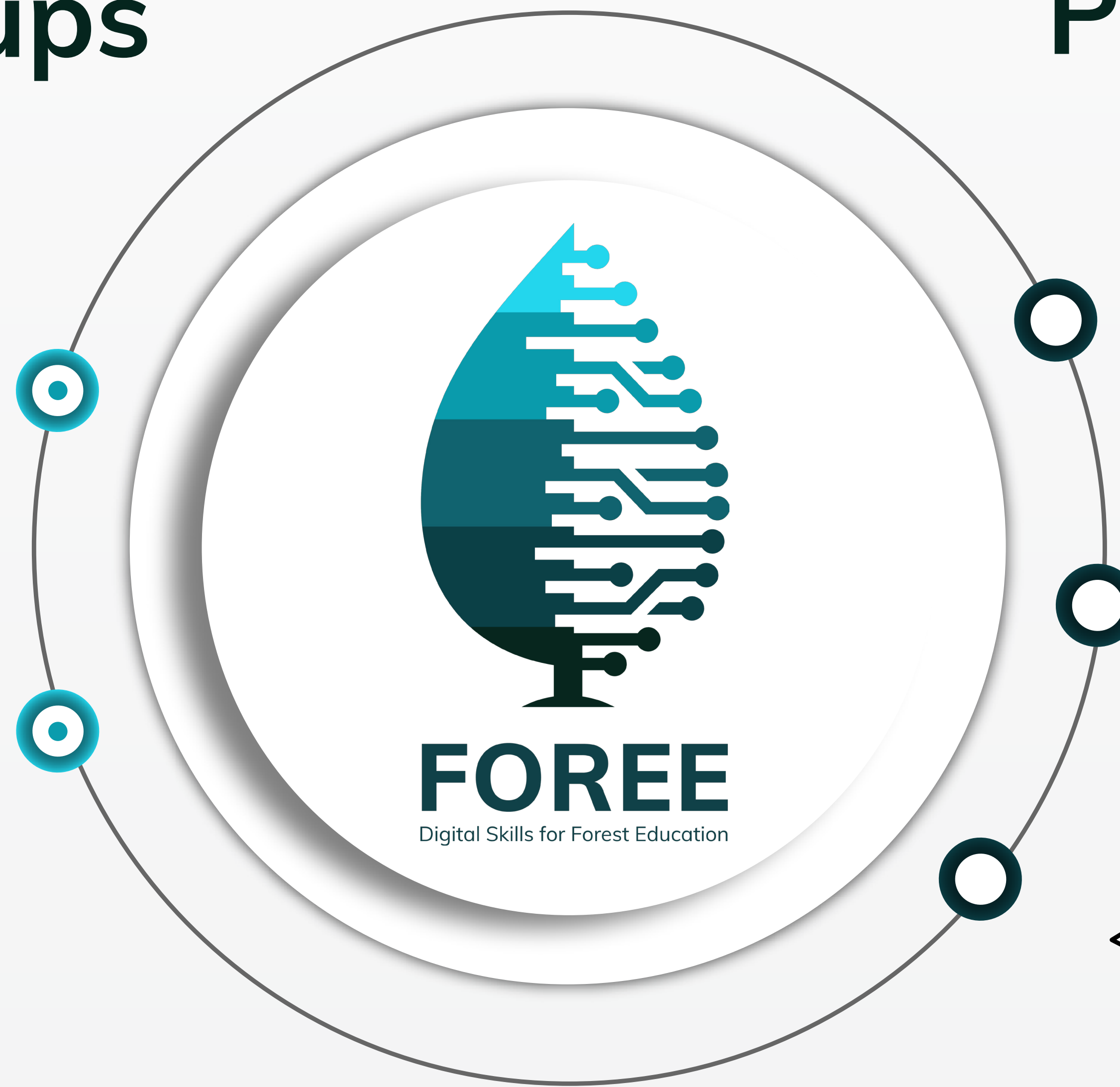

Teachers, trainers, teacher educators, developer of courses and learning formats

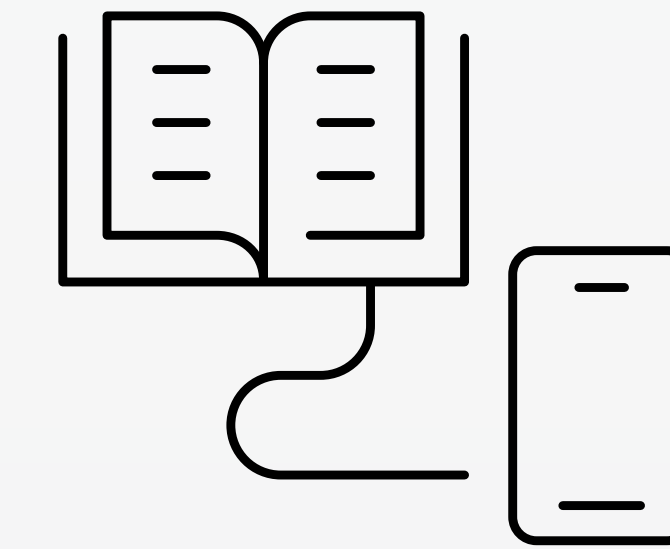

Project results



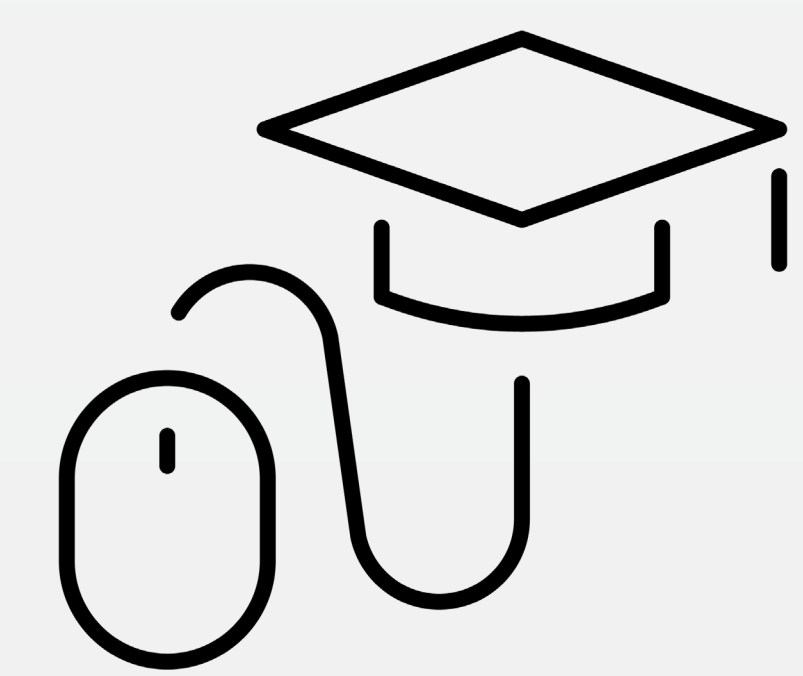
Train-the-Trainer Course
